All Hallows Eve is the traditional name for Halloween. It marks the evening before the Christian holy day of All Hallows Day / All Saints Day. All Hallows Eve grew out of the ancient Gaelic festival of Samhain, "Summer's End," when they believed the walls between our world and the spirit world became thin.

During the festivities, the poor visited the houses of the wealthy, where they would receive soul cakes in exchange for a promise to pray for the homeowners' dead relatives, a practice known as "souling." This evolved into "guising" where young people in Scotland and Ireland dressed up in costumes and performed songs, poems or jokes in exchange for fruit and nuts. The tradition was taken to the America by immigrants in the early 1900s, and became known as trick-or-treating.
